


# Air Operated End Lift

**Operating Instructions & Parts Manual**

#### SAFETY and GENERAL INFORMATION

**Save these instructions.** For your safety *read, understand, and follow* the information provided with and on this lift. The owner and operator of this equipment shall have an understanding of this lift and safe operating procedures before attempting to use. The owner and operator shall be aware that use and repair of this product may require special skills and knowledge. Instructions and safety information shall be conveyed in the operator's native language before use of this lift is authorized. If any doubt exists as to the safe and proper use of this lift, remove from service immediately.

**Inspect before each use.** Do not use if broken, bent, cracked, or damaged parts (including labels) are noted. Any lift that appears damaged in any way, operates abnormally or is missing parts, shall be removed from service immediately and the manufacturer notified. If you suspect that the lift was subjected to a shock load (a load dropped suddenly, unexpectedly upon it), immediately discontinue use until the lift has been checked by a factory authorized service center (contact distributor or manufacturer for list of Authorized Service Centers). It is recommended that an annual inspection be done by qualified personnel. Replace worn or damaged parts with Hein-Werner Authorized Replacement Parts only. Labels and owner's manuals are available from manufacturer.

#### PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

Hein-Werner Air Operated End Lift is designed to lift, but not support rated capacity loads. **Intended use:** To engage the metal bumper of a vehicle and raise for the purpose of service and/or repair of vehicle components. Immediately after lifting, the load must be supported by a pair of appropriately rated jack stands.



**Never** use lift as a stand alone device. After lifting, **immediately** support the lifted load with a pair of appropriately rated jack stands.




Figure 1 - Model HW93690 Components

- Do not exceed rated capacity.
- Use only on hard, level surface.
- This is a lifting device only!
- **Immediately** after lifting, support the load with **a pair** of appropriately rated jack stands.
- · Center load on saddle.
- Do not use adapters or accessories that are not provided initially.
- Never lift vehicle which cannot roll freely forward and backward during lift.
- Lift only on areas of the vehicle as specified by the vehicle manufacturer.
- · Do not move or dolly loads with this device.
- No alterations shall be made to this product.

#### **PREPARATION**

#### **Before Use**

- 1. Verify that the product and application are compatible, if in doubt call Hein-Werner technical service.
- 2. Before use, read the operator's manual completely and familiarize yourself thoroughly with the product, its components and recognize the potential hazards associated with its use.
- 3. Ensure that lift rolls freely, the air cylinder operates smoothly, raises and lowers the unloaded saddle throughout the lifting range before putting into service.
- 4. Ensure the lift is loaded on center with the saddles placed equal distance from the center.
- 5. Replace worn or damaged parts and assemblies with Hein-Werner Replacement Parts only. Lubricate as instructed in Maintenance Section.

#### Prepare air system

Connect 1/4" NPT quick coupler of your choice to the air input (Fig. 1).

Note: Air source must supply 200 psi maximum to each lift operated.

#### **OPERATION**



Only attachments and/or adapters supplied by the manufacturer shall be used. Lift only on areas of the vehicle as specified by the vehicle manufacturer.



**NEVER** use lift as a stand alone device! **ALWAYS** transfer the lifted load **IMMEDIATELY** to a pair of appropriately rated jack stands. Use one pair of jack stands per vehicle. Rated capacity is per pair only! Do not exceed rated capacity.

#### Lifting

- 1. Ensure that the vehicle is on a flat, hard and level surface and is free to roll forward and backward during the lift.
- 2. Connect 1/4" NPT air nipple and air hose to air inlet port.
- 3. To adjust the length of the lifting beams, pull both beam extensions out evenly to suitable length.



**NEVER** extend beam extensions beyond locked position. Retaining bar of the beam extensions must be secured together with the locking bolt.

- 4. Adjust the saddle height by pulling saddle tube up, then insert the support pin through the hole on saddle tube.
- 5. For low pickup height, uncsrew the locking bolt and nut, then rotate the beam extensions 180 degrees. Refer to Figure 2.



- 6. Make sure both saddles are positioned directly under the vehicle manufacturer's recommended lift points.
- 7. To raise lift, slowly push the lift control lever toward the right until saddles contact with the lift point.

  !STOP! RELEASE THE LIFT CONTROL LEVEL! Confirm that the saddles are positioned correctly, then continue to push the lever until load reaches desired height. Simply release the lever to stop.
- 8. Transfer the load immediately to appropriately rated jack stands.

#### Lowering



Be sure all tools and personnel are clear before lowering load. **Maintain control** of the rate of speed at which the load lowers at all times!

- 1. Raise load high enough to clear the jack stands, then carefully remove jack stands (always used in pairs).
- 2. Slowly lower the load by disengaging safety bar\* and push lift control lever toward the left.
- \* To disengage safety bar: Push safety bar lever towards front end of the lift.

#### **MAINTENANCE**

Lubricate all moving parts with oil/grease.

#### Lubrication

A periodic coating of light lubricating oil to pivot points, axles and hinges will help to prevent rust and assure that wheels, and caster assemblies move freely.

#### Storage

When not in use, store the lift with cylinder fully lowered.

### **TROUBLESHOOTING**

Symptom	Possible Causes	Corrective Action
The lift will not lift load	Air pressure too low	200 psi minimum air pressure required to lift rated load
	Air hose kinked or plugged	Remove kinks and obstruction from air hose
	Air hose inner diameter too small	Consult air compressor manufacturer for the correct size of hose
	Air cylinder / components damaged	Contact Hein-Werner repair center
Lift will not lower after unloading	Safety bar engaged	Press lift control valve to raise lift slightly, then disengage safety bar
	Structural damage to lift assembly	Contact Hein-Werner repair center
Lift raises or lowers with jerky motion	Cylinder might need lubrication	Apply #630-AAA LUBRIPLATE to cylinder wall




Figure 3 - Replacement Parts Illustration for Model HW93690
